AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NORTH BAY COOPERATIVE LIBRARY SYSTEM,
HEREINAFTER CALLED "SYSTEM," AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA
AT DAVIS LIBRARY, HEREINAFTER CALLED "UNIVERSITY LIBRARY."

## PURPOSE:

The Library of the University of California at Davis is an important research library resource for interlibrary loans and for reference referrals from public libraries in the North Bay Cooperative Library System.

The Board of Directors of the North Bay Cooperative Library System proposes to extend affiliate System membership to the Library of the University of California at Davis. Affiliate membership will facilitate the association between the System and the University and impose certain conditions for the exchange of services.

## AGREEMENTS:

- 1. System member libraries and their patrons will have access to the University Library through the System's reference referral network. The reference coordinators at either of the designated Area Libraries will screen all requests and will determine which ones will be referred to the University Library.
- 2. The University Librarian will designate an individual on the University Library staff to serve as liaison between the System's reference referral network and the University Library.
- 3. The University Library will extend library privileges (borrower card and stack privileges) to System staff members. Certain designated System staff members will be permitted to use the University Library facilities. Material will be checked out to member libraries of the System and will be handled by them in the same manner as all other interlibrary loans.
- 4. This agreement does not entitle a library borrower to bypass his local-public library for materials or information. Direct borrowing or the seeking of research assistance is a matter between the individual and the University Library. It is not the intent of this agreement to have the resources of the University Library (materials or professional expertise) become a substitute for the resources of the individual System member libraries.

- 5. The System delivery van will make regular stops at the University Library.
- 6. The university Library will use a TWX to communicate with the System's interlibrary loan headquarters to facilitate speedy service.
- 7. The University Librarian or an alternate designated by him may attend the regular meetings of the System Board of Directors. He will be an observer and may not vote on System matters until such time as the System may accept academic libraries as full members and the Library of the University of California at Davis may desire to join.
- 8. This agreement may be terminated by either party 30 days after notification of desire to terminate is given in writing.
- 9. This agreement complies with the California Library Network Master Plan which states "the total library collections of California must in the future be regarded as a general public resource."
