Brown Act:

The legislative body of a local agency may use teleconferencing in connection with any meeting or proceeding authorized by law. Cal. Gov't Code §54953(b)(1). A "teleconference" is "a meeting of a legislative body, the members of which are in different locations, connected by electronic means, through either audio or video, or both." Cal. Gov't Code § 54953(b)(4). A local agency may provide the public with additional teleconference locations. Cal. Gov't Code § 54953(b)(4).

The teleconferenced meeting must meet the following requirements:

- (1) it must comply with all of the Act's requirements applicable to other meetings;
- (2) all votes must be taken by roll call;

(3) agendas must be posted at all teleconference locations and the meeting must be conducted in a manner that protects the statutory and constitutional rights of the parties or public appearing before the body;

(4) each teleconference location must be identified in the notice and agenda and each location must be accessible to the public;

(5) during the teleconferenced meeting, at least a quorum of the members of the legislative body must participate from locations within the boundaries of the body's jurisdiction; and

(6) the agenda must provide the public with an opportunity to address the legislative body at each teleconference location. Cal. Gov't Code § 54953(b).

At the Annual Meeting of the NBCLS Board of Directors, June 7, 2019, the Board approved up to \$2,000 to contract with Best, Best and Krieger attorney, Isabel Safie, for legal research and reporting on NBCLS's obligation for on-going payment on the one retiree's health benefits and recourse for communications with nonactive and former NBCLS member libraries.

Upon receiving a Scope of Service and fee estimate from Ms. Safie of approximately \$5,000 for work on these two questions, NBCLS leadership is recommending approval of an additional \$3,000 to cover the estimated "not to exceed" total of \$5,000 for legal fees on these two questions.

The breakdown of cost estimate from BB&K is as follows:

QUESTION 1

- Scope of Work: We'll need to review all relevant documents that describe the benefit, including the SEIU MOU and personnel file documents that describe the benefits offered to the retiree. We'll apply existing law at it pertains to the vesting of retiree health benefits and assess what the NBCLS obligation is. We will then prepare a memorandum setting forth our conclusions and recommendations.
- **Cost Estimate**: \$3,000 \$3,500

QUESTION 2

- Scope of Work: The legal analysis on this issue has already been done through the earlier work that we did for NorthNet. While I would need to review all available documents, this should not require much time. In fact, unless the documents provide unexpected information, I expect that this question can be addressed fairly easily (I do have a preliminary answer already)
- **Cost Estimate**: \$1,200-\$1,500

Ms. Safie will provide an analysis and recommendation for next NBCLS Board meeting, scheduled for August 29, 2019.
