WHEREAS: Susan Hagijs always fostered cooperation by offering support to all libraries in the North Bay area and actively recruited school libraries into the membership; then

BE IT RESOLVED: that Susan Hagijs upon her well deserved retirement receives the acclaim and the appreciation of the members of the NBCLS Board of Directors for all of her many contributions to the health and prosperity of NBCLS today.
